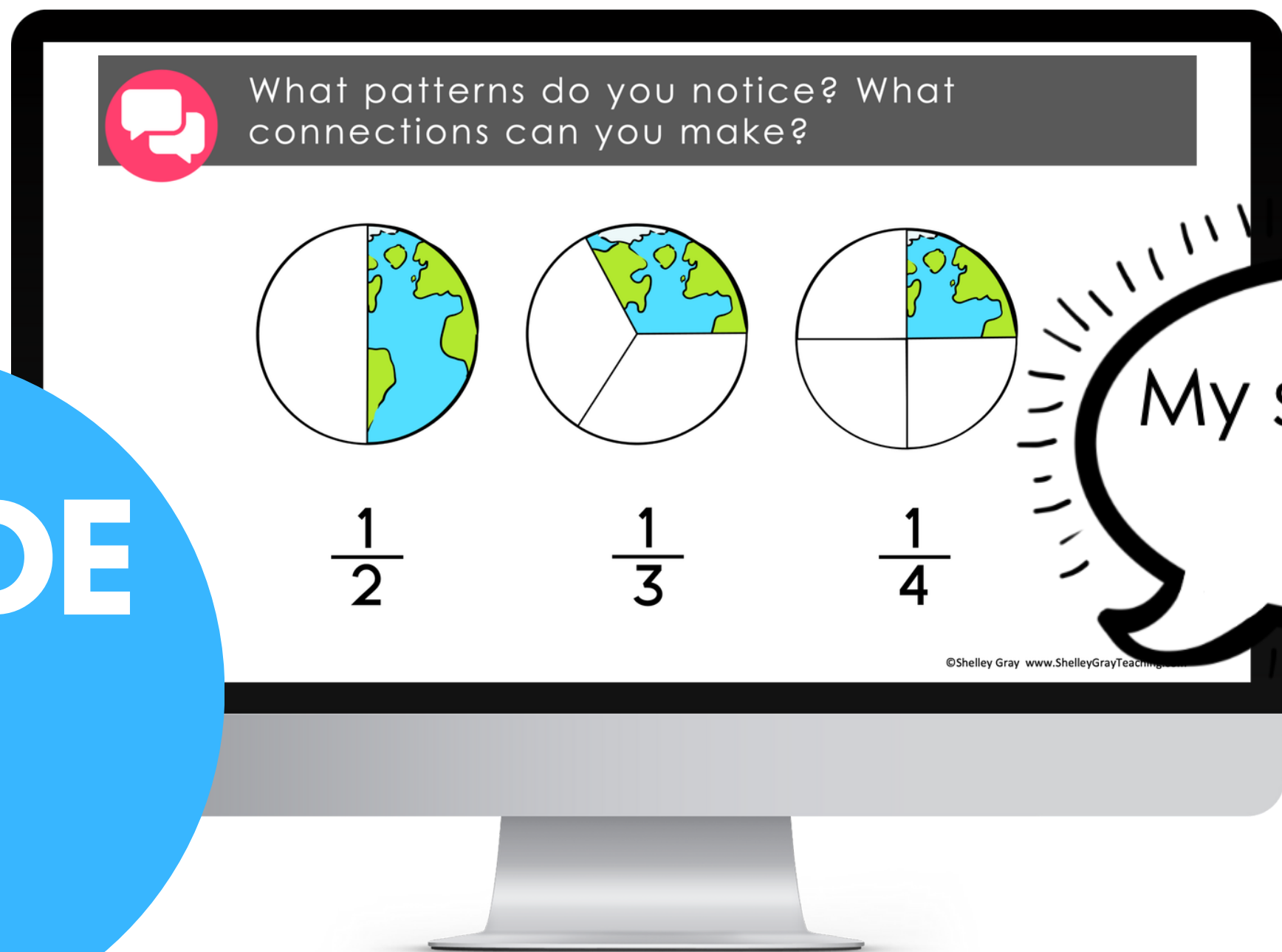

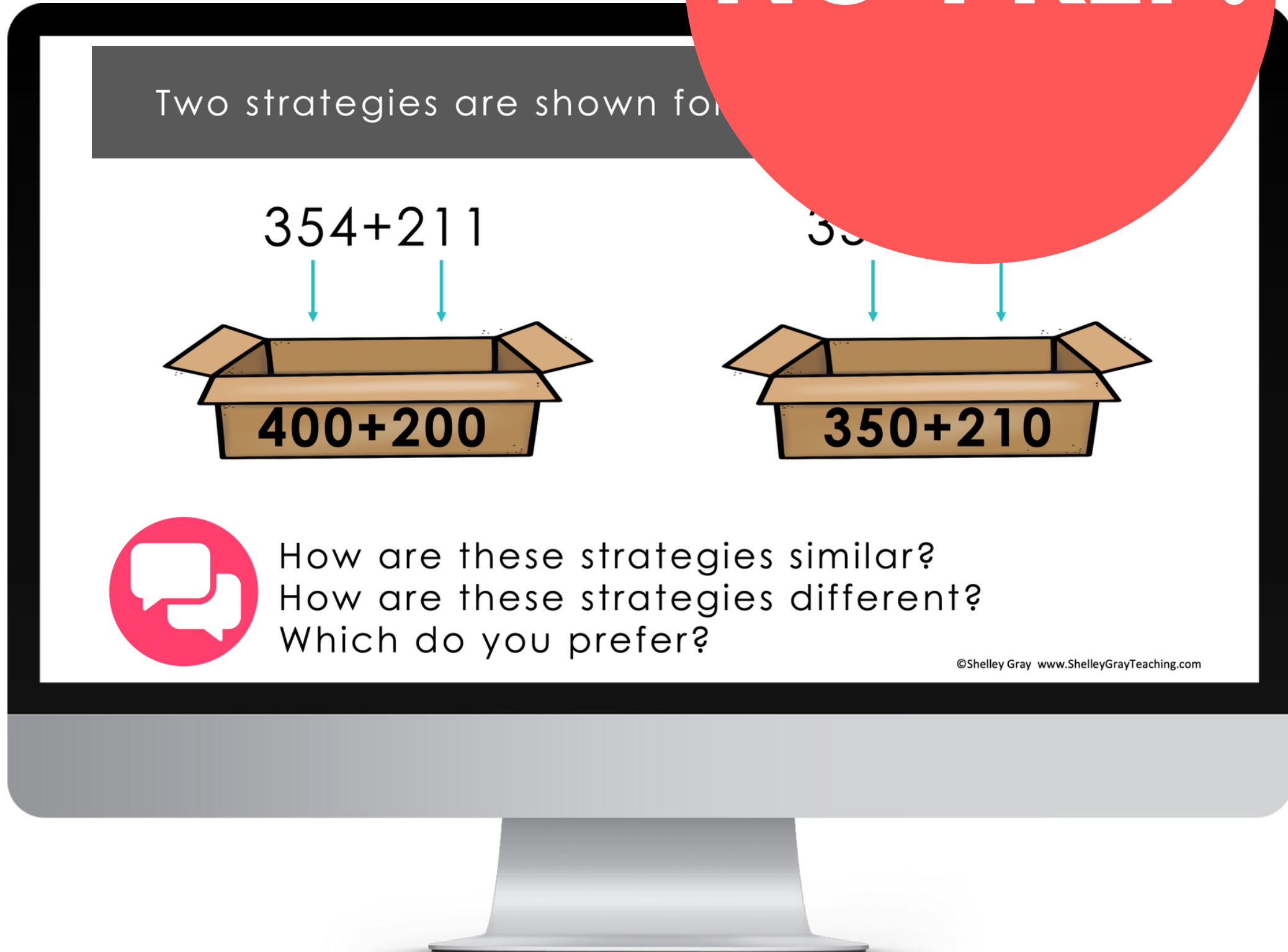
Earth Day Math Conversations is designed to help your students:

The main goal is to get you and your students **talking about math** and realizing that math is not all about right answers – it's about **thinking in different ways!**

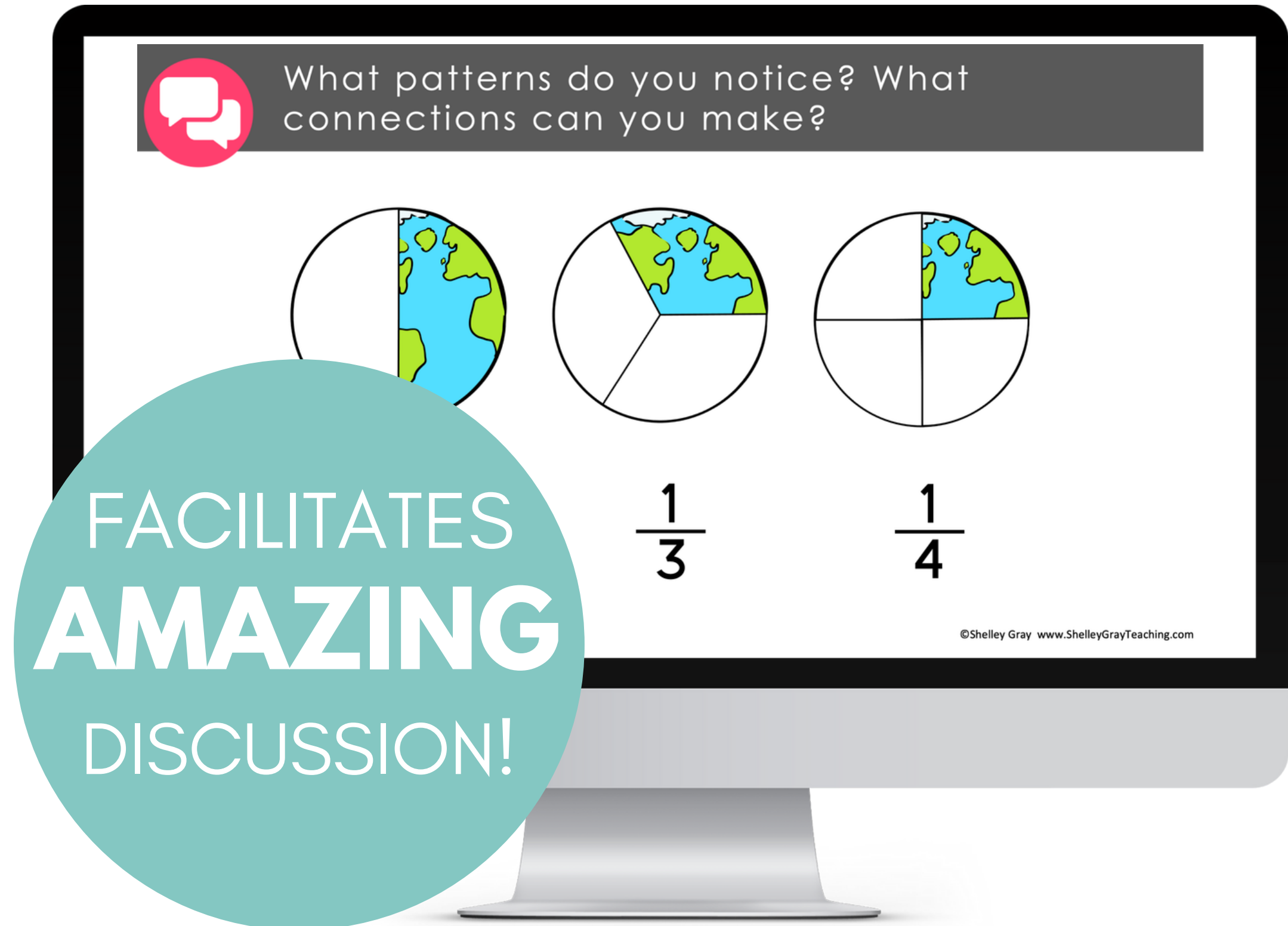

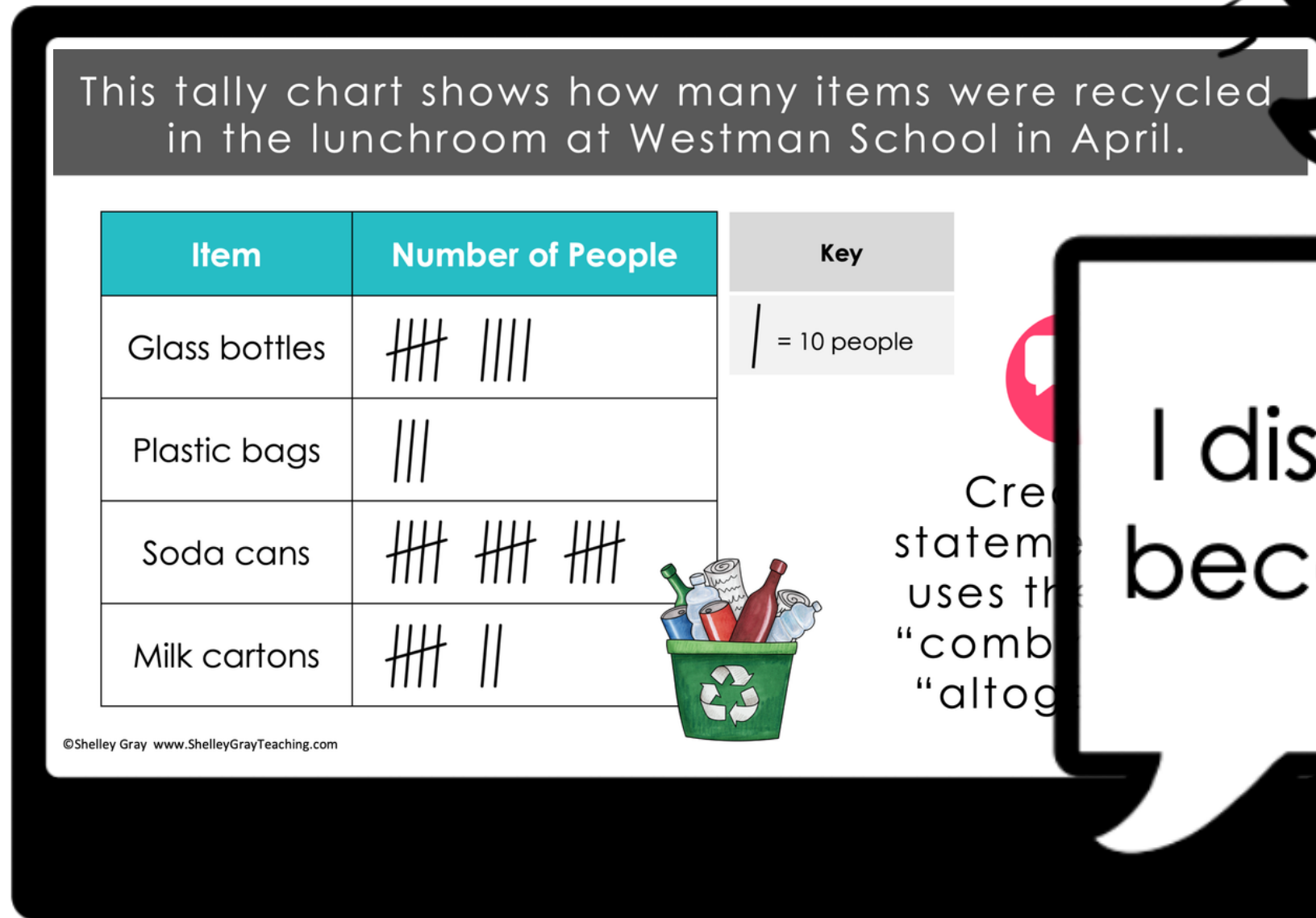
