Part-part-whole relationships are a critical milestone in math development. These task cards will help your students understand these relationships, building deep, flexible, foundational number sense.

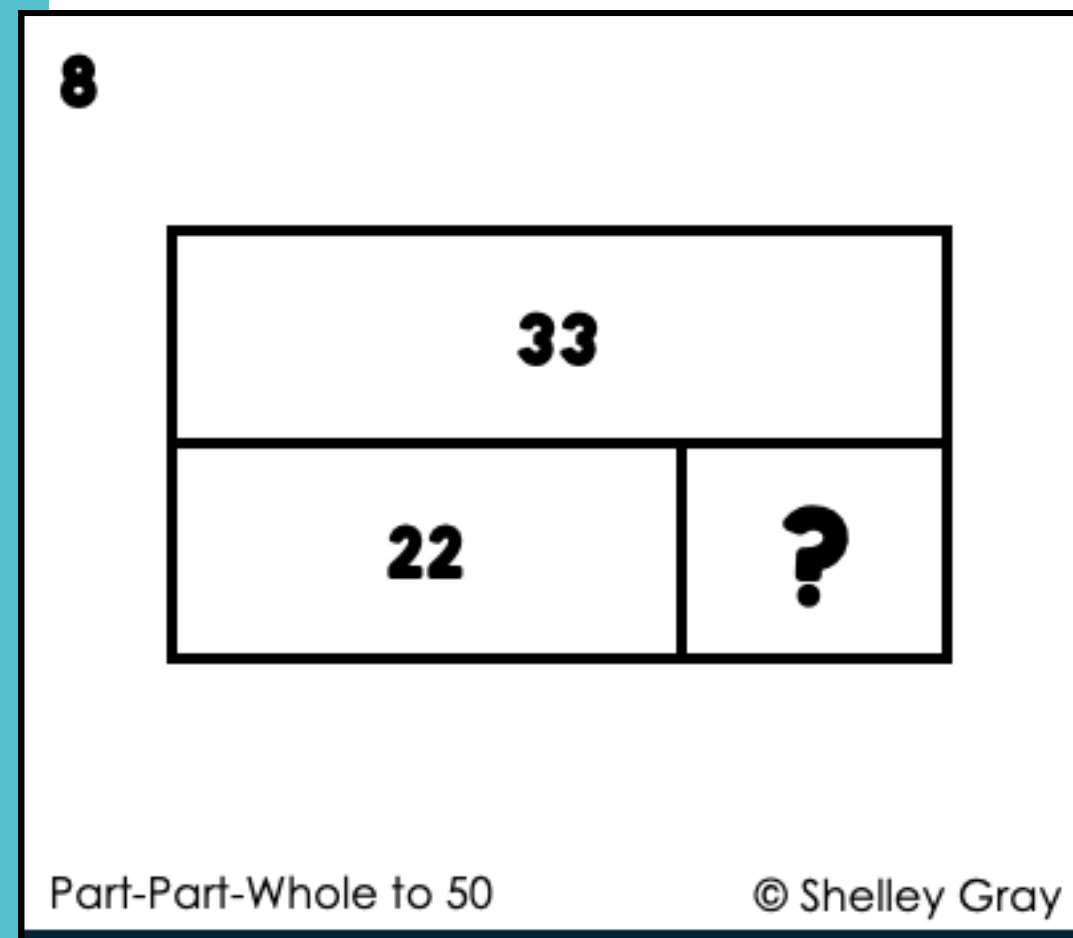

$$33-22=11$$

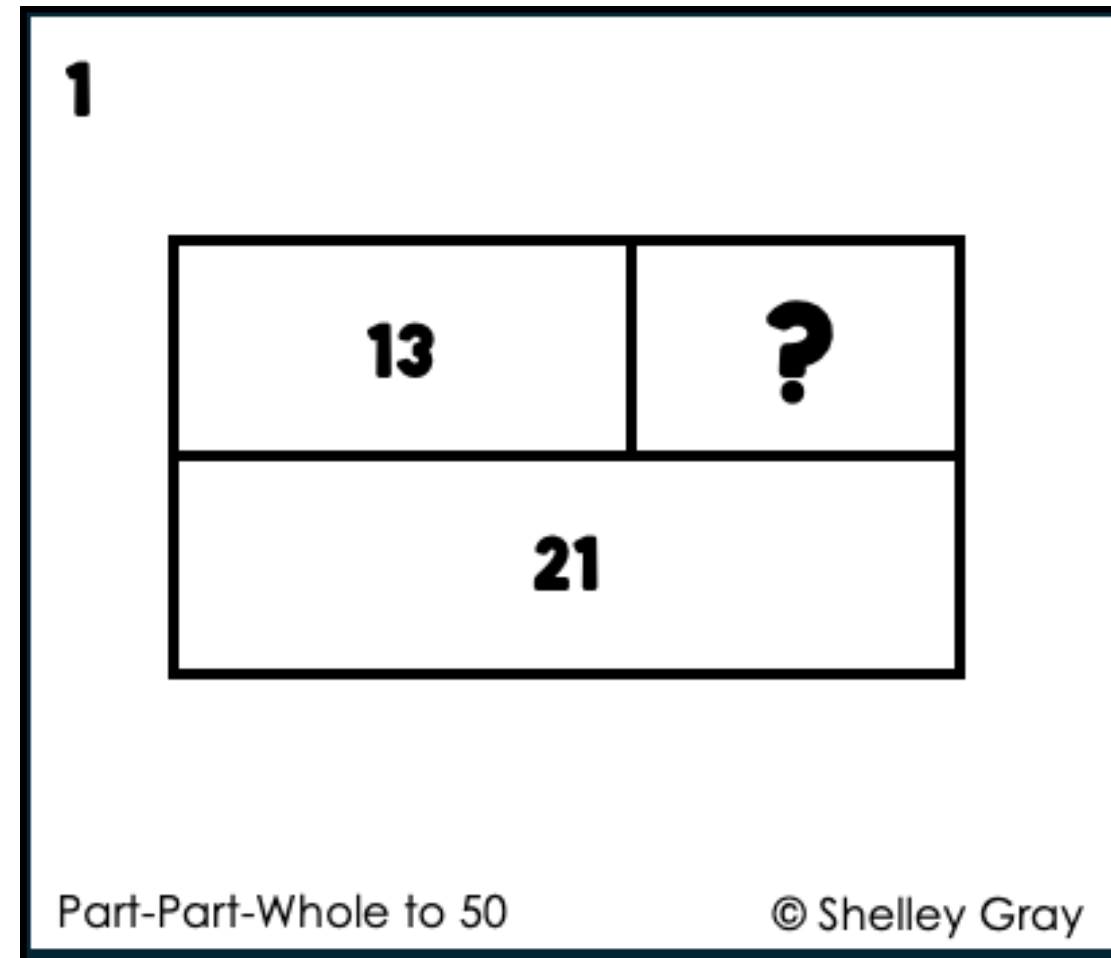
