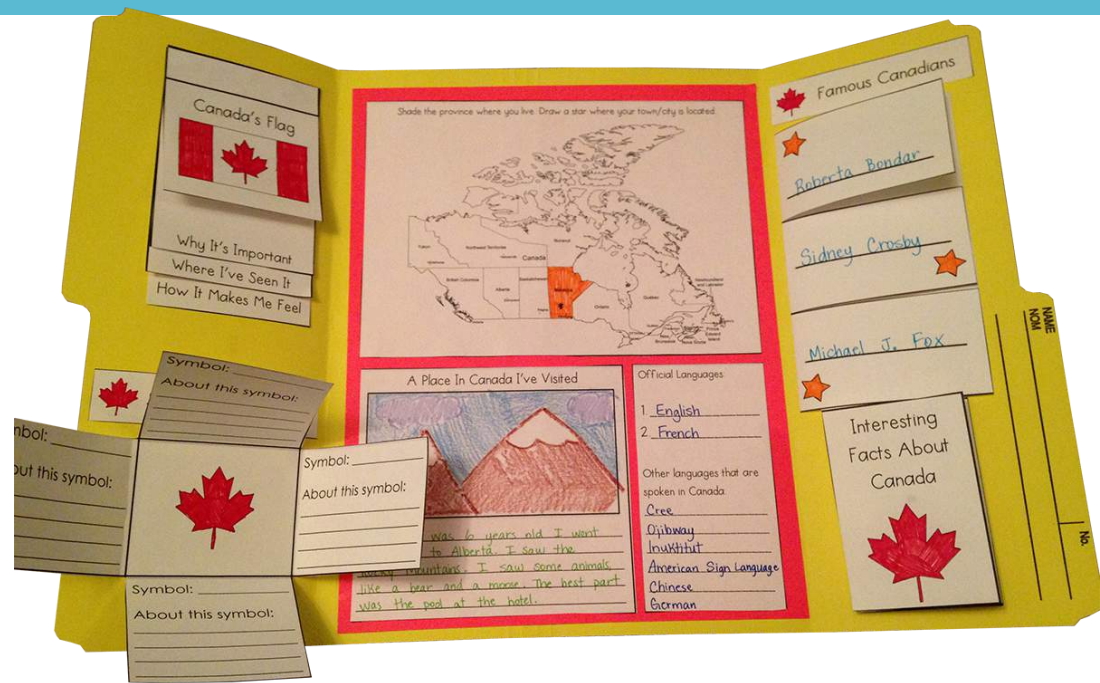
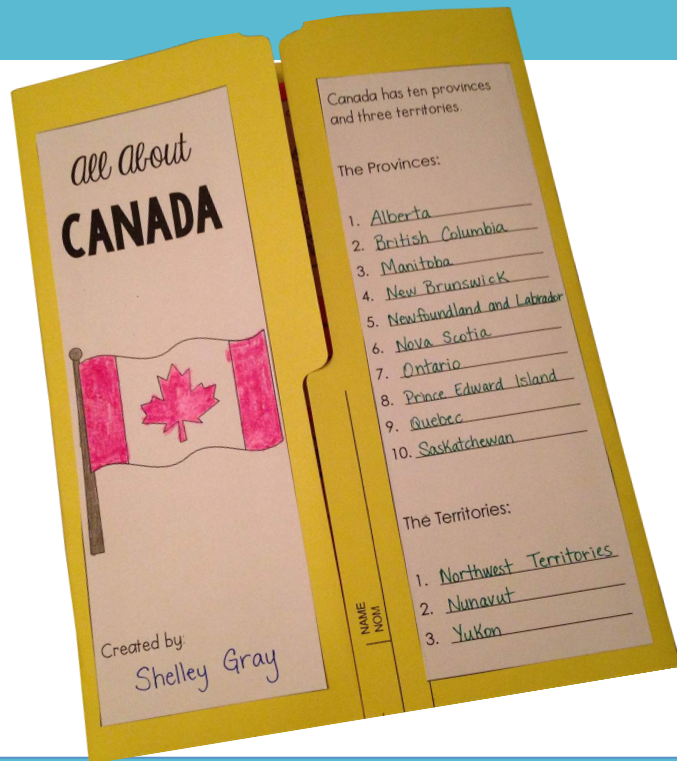

or however else you see fit!

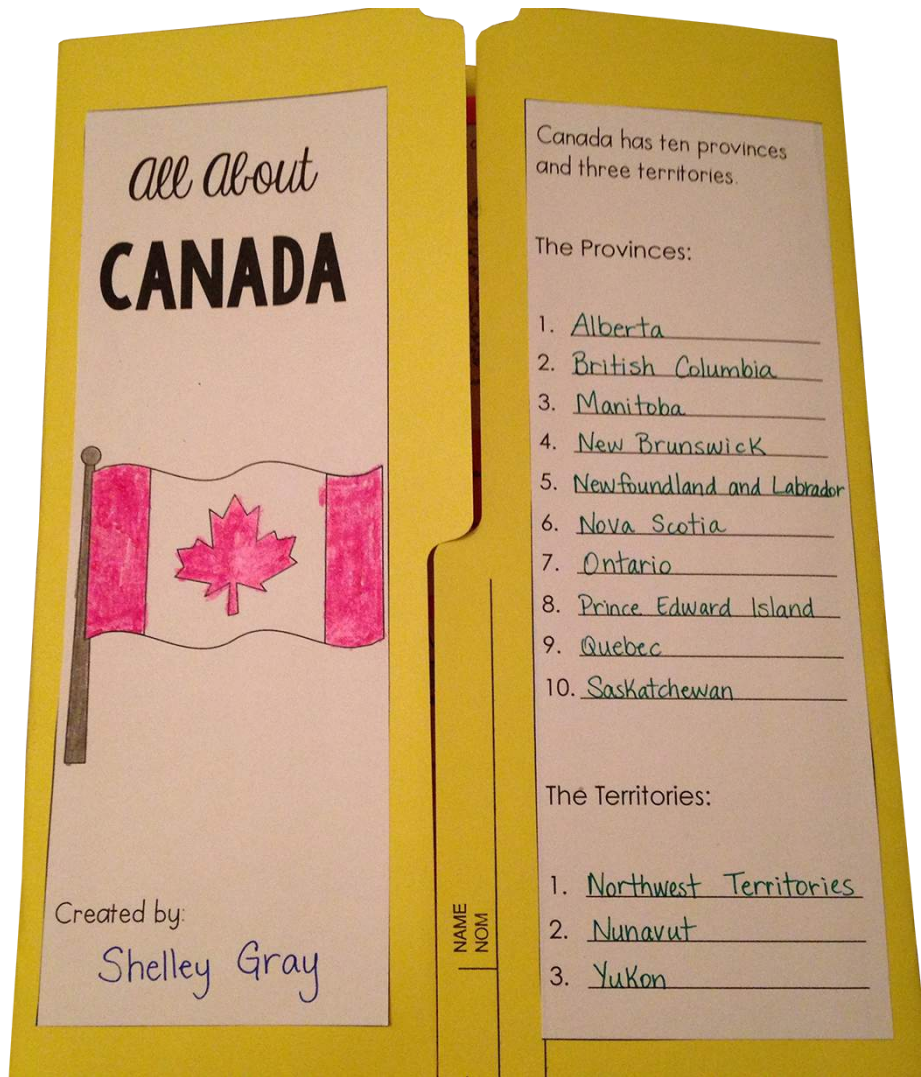
Materials:

To create this lapbook, each student will need:

- scissors
- glue (white glue works best, but a glue stick is also fine)
- colored pencils, markers, etc.

Each student will also need to conduct research to complete the lapbook. For younger students, the teacher may choose to do a whole-class research. Even if you do a whole-class research, I recommend allowing students some option when it comes to their lapbooks. This will increase the feeling of ownership and increase student engagement.

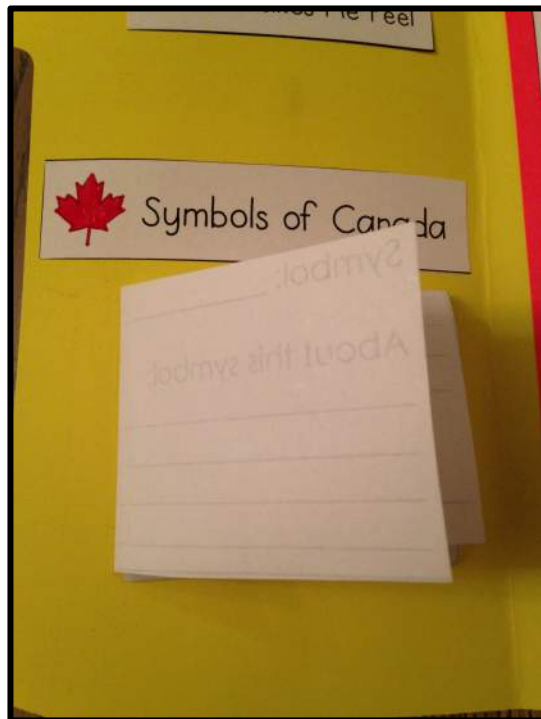

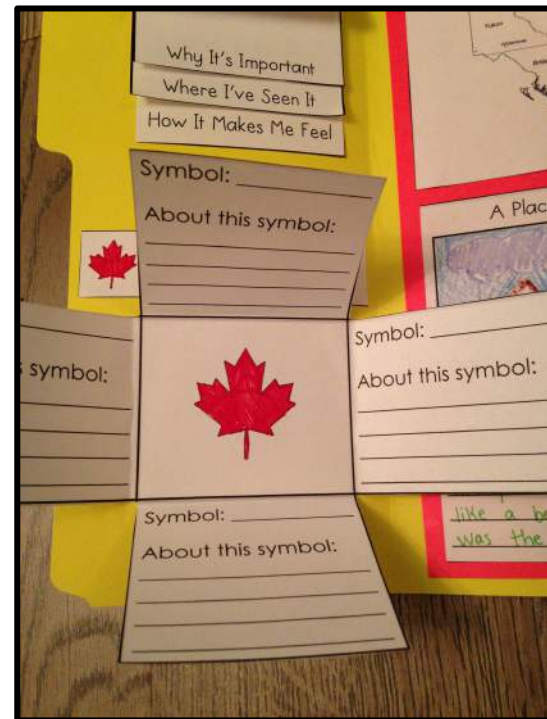

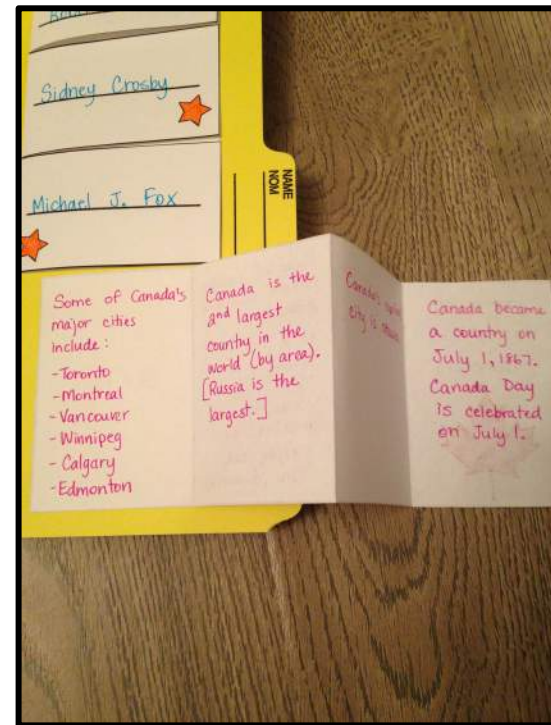
