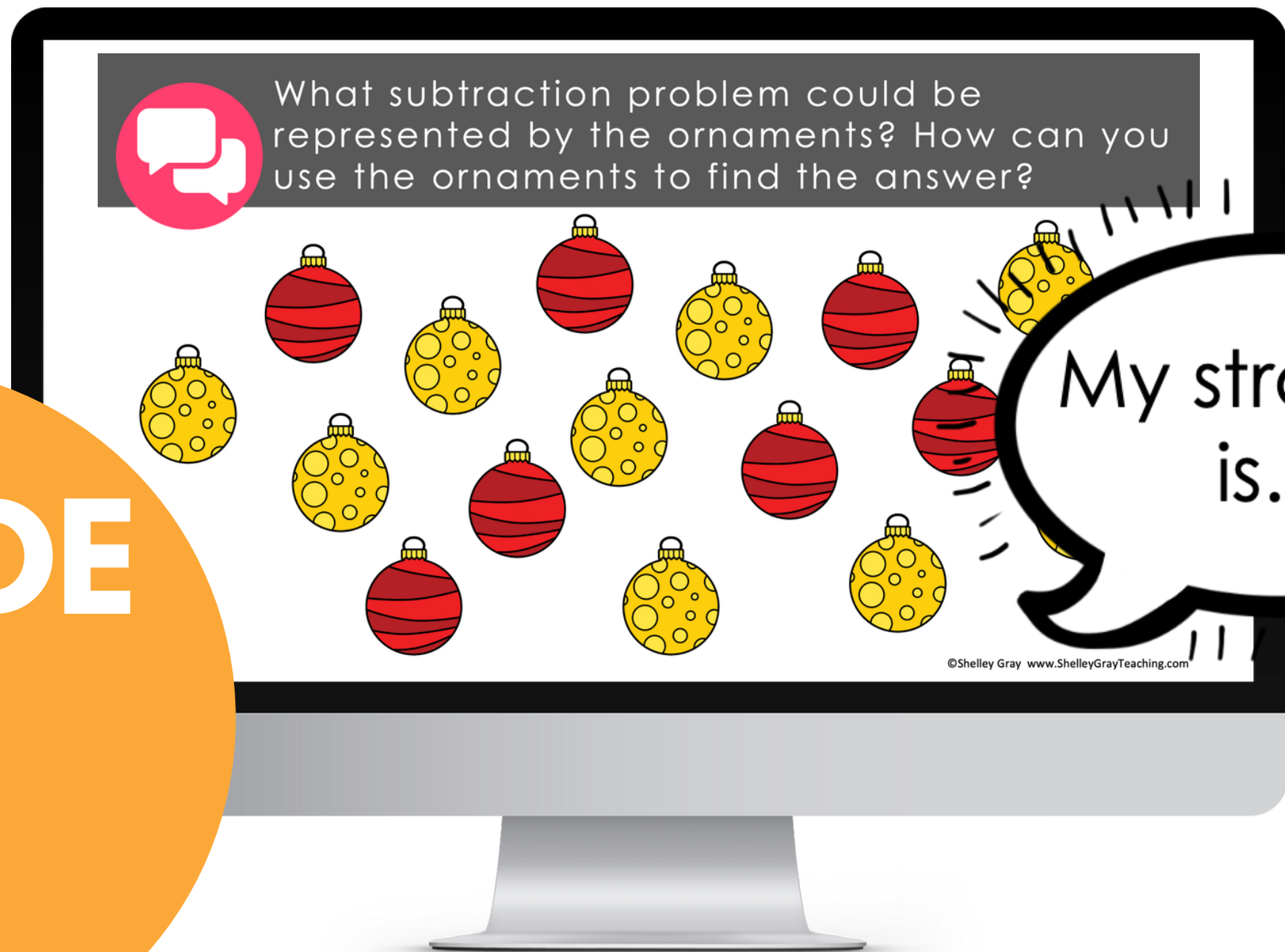

build number sense

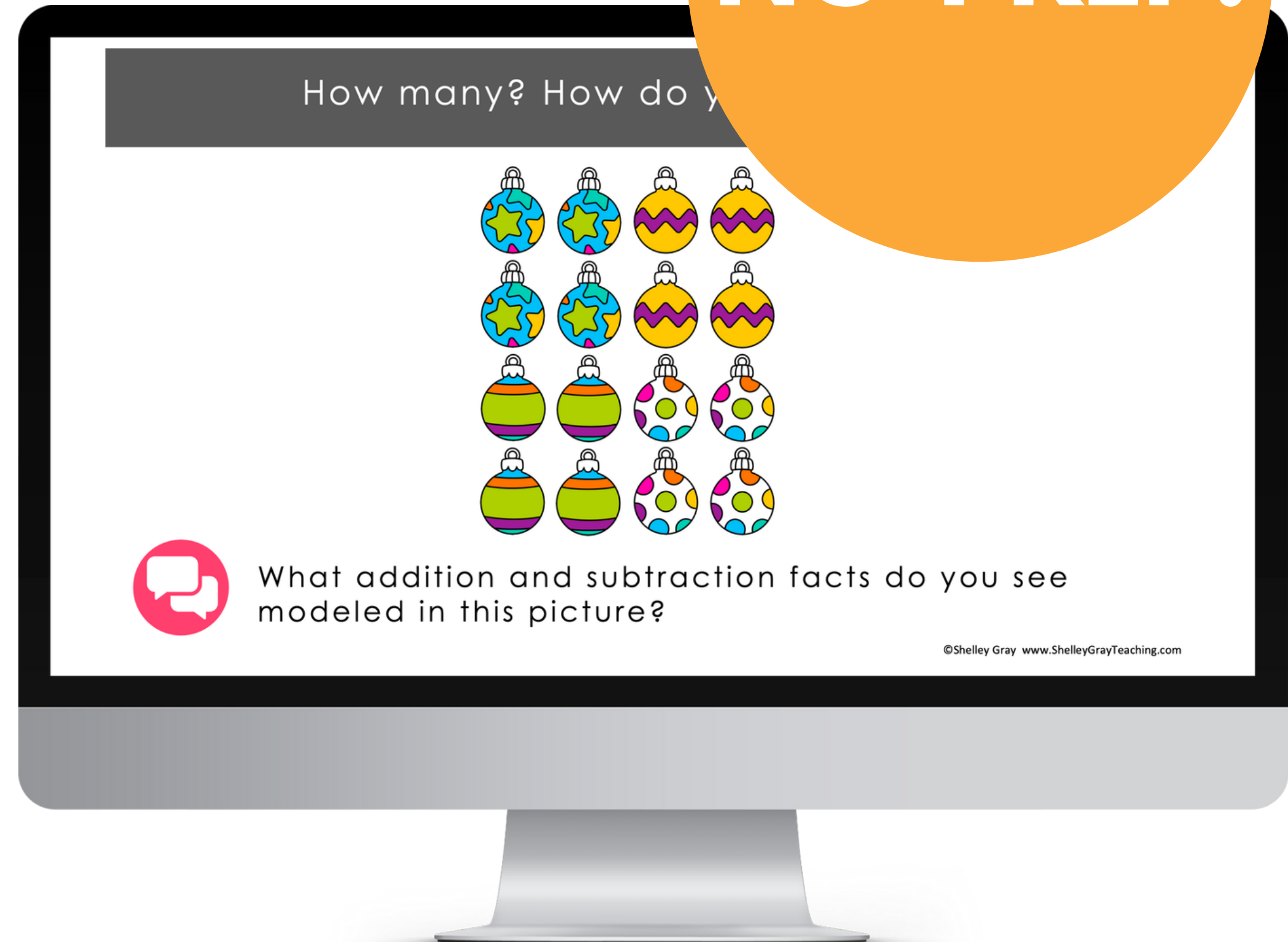
become strategic and flexible thinkers

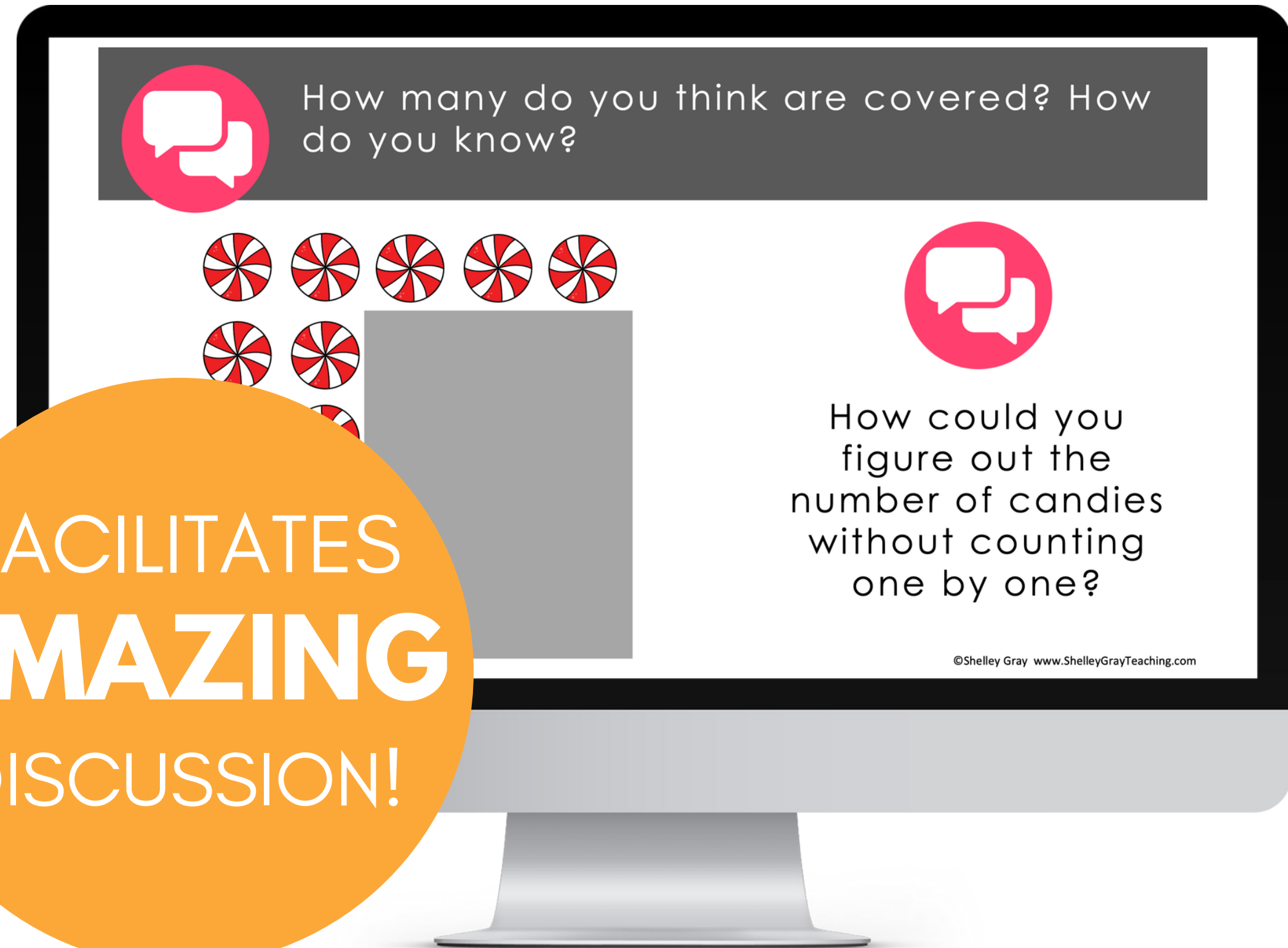

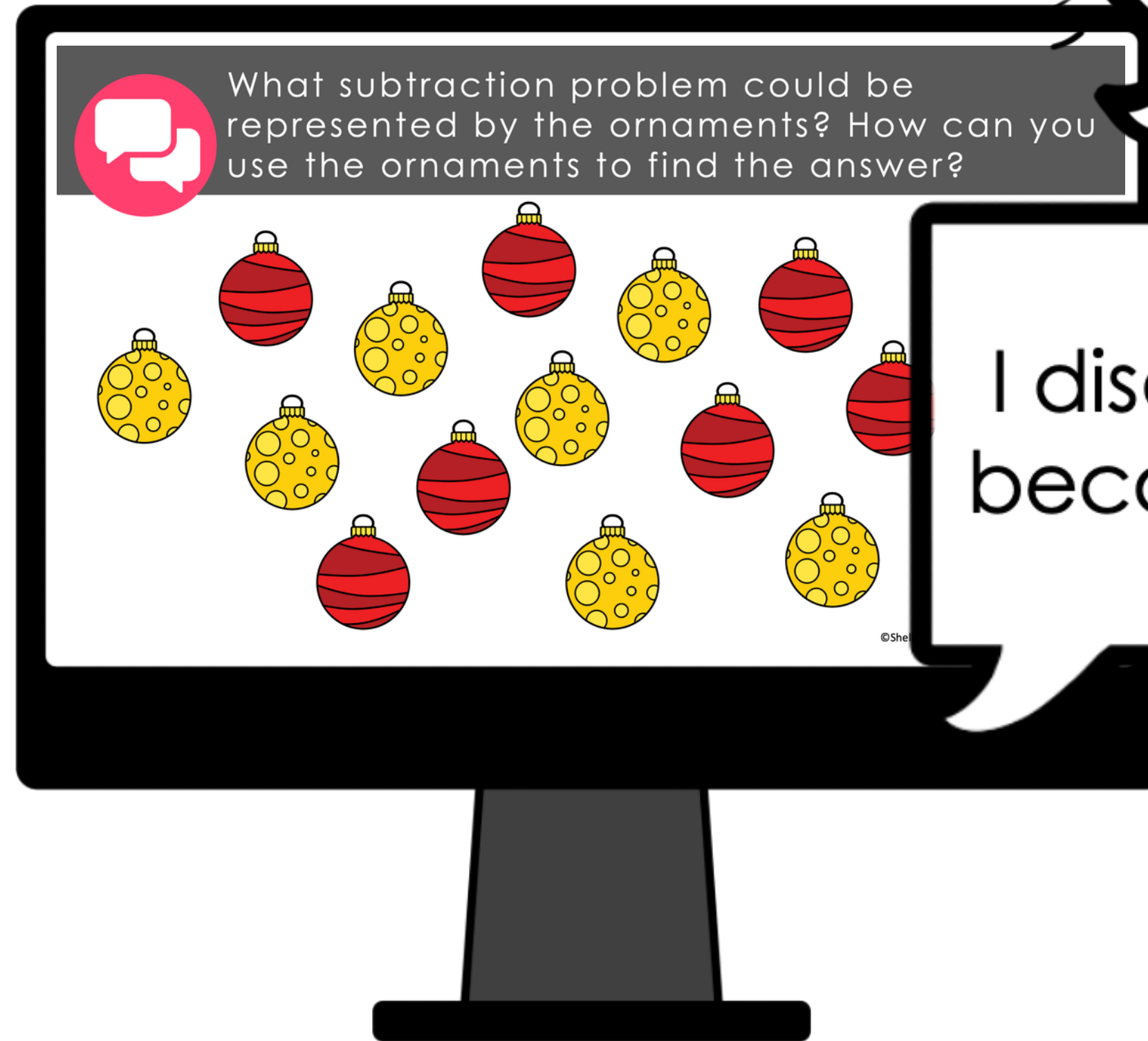
