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About this Resource

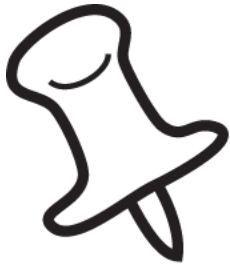
This book-tivity is an engaging way to reinforce parts of speech concepts. Students will practice working with basic parts of speech – nouns, verbs and adjectives. This book-tivity makes a great literacy center activity. It can also be used as a formal assessment or an artifact to display during parent-teacher conferences.



Both color and black-and-white templates are included.

Depending on the age of students that you teach, you may want to prepare parts of this activity for the students. For example, upper elementary students should be able to make this book from start to finish; however if you teach lower elementary students, you may choose to prepare the books ahead of time, and have students simply complete the templates.
